



## **JAM EXCHANGE 2026 FAQ's**

### **Does everyone need a ticket and jam to participate?**

Jam Swap participants require a ticket and must bring six jars of jam. The JAM Marketplace is free entry for the public.

### **Can I buy more than one ticket?**

Yes, you may purchase multiple tickets. Each participant must bring their own six jars of jam.

### **What happens if tickets sell out?**

A waitlist will be made available if additional capacity opens.

### **What time should I arrive?**

The event runs from 9:00am to 2:00pm. Jam Swap participants must register and submit jars within the designated registration window. Late arrivals may not be able to participate.

### **What are the jam requirements?**

Each participant must bring six jars (250–300ml) of homemade jam. All jars must be sealed, labelled with ingredients and allergens, and presented cleanly.

### **What is the event schedule?**

A detailed program will be provided prior to the event and is available on the website

### **Can I get a refund?**

All Jam Swap ticket purchases are final, non-refundable and non-transferable.

### **Is there an age restriction?**

Participants under 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

**Can children and dogs attend?**

Children are welcome with supervision. And whilst animals are NOT permitted at the Centennial Vineyards event, you CAN BRING dogs on a leash to JAM EXCHANGE at Bowral Public School.

**What happens if it rains?**

The event will proceed in light rain. Severe weather may result in schedule adjustments or relocation, with notice provided.

**What if I have dietary requirements?**

All jars must list ingredients and allergens. Guests consume at their own discretion.

**Do I need to bring ID?**

Yes, valid ID is required at registration if you are a JAM SWAP participant – no ID needed to attend the JAM MARKETS
